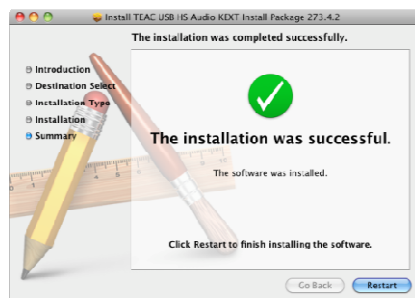
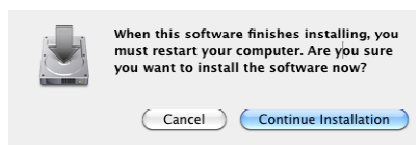
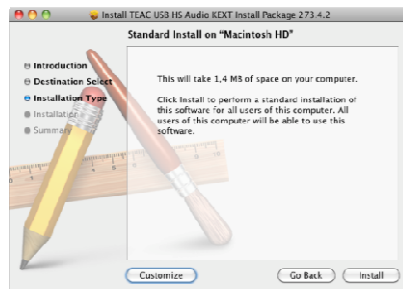
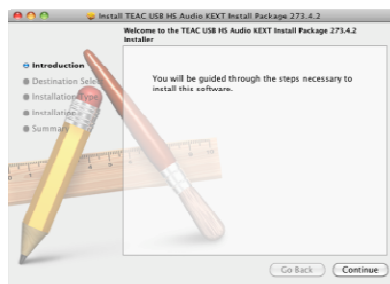
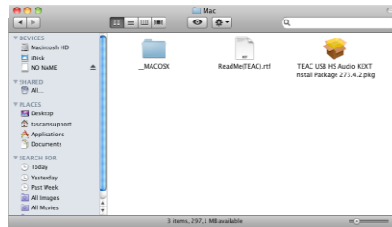
Before connecting your TEAC USB DAC, be sure to install the supplied device drivers.

Mac OS X

1. To install the driver software, execute “**TEAC USB HS Audio KEXT Install Package 273.4.2.pkg**” and follow the Installation Assistant.

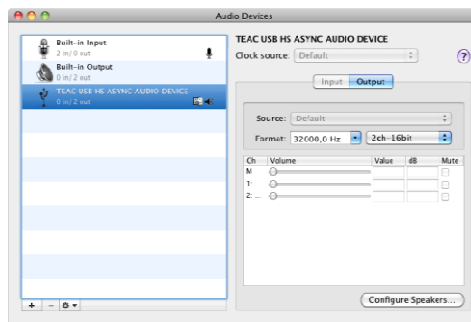


2. After having performed a restart, please connect your TEAC DAC to your Mac via USB. Set the input SOURCE of your TEAC DAC to “**USB**”.

3. Open the utilities by following **Finder - Go - Utilities**



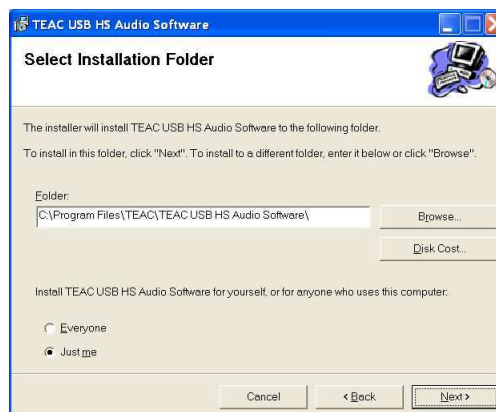
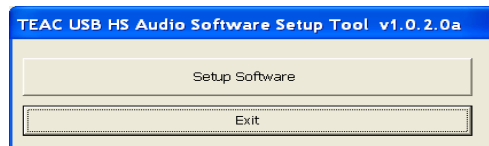
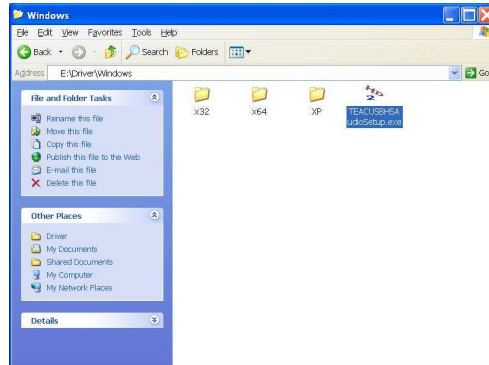
4. Select **“Audio-MIDI-Setup“**

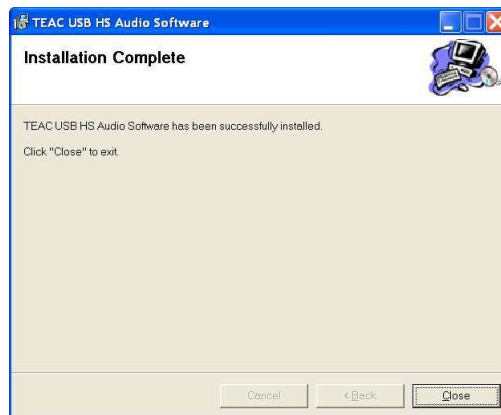
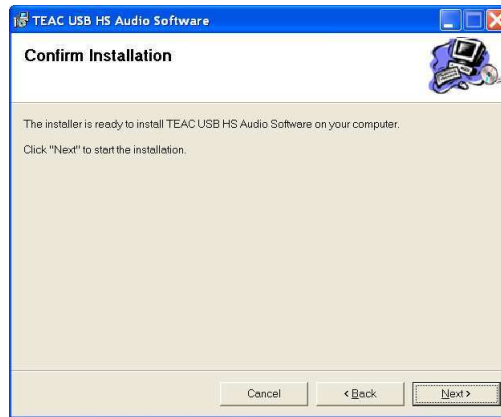


5. Mark the **“TEAC USB HS ASYNC AUDIO DEVICE“** and select **“Use this device for sound output“** in the settings.
6. Using **“Format“** you can select the desired Sample Frequency and Resolution (Bit Rate).
7. Your Mac is now configured to use your TEAC DAC as an external audio device.

Windows XP

1. For installation of the device driver software, please execute „TEACUSBHSAudioSetup.exe“ and follow the instructions of the Setup Wizard.



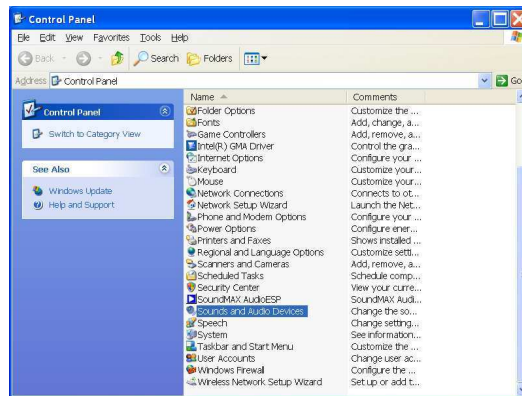


2. You can now connect your TEAC DAC to your PC via USB.
Set the input SOURCE of your TEAC DAC to **“USB”**.
3. Windows will now recognize and install your TEAC DAC hardware. After successful hardware installation your TEAC DAC will be configured as an external USB Soundcard and automatically defined to be your “Default device” for audio playback.

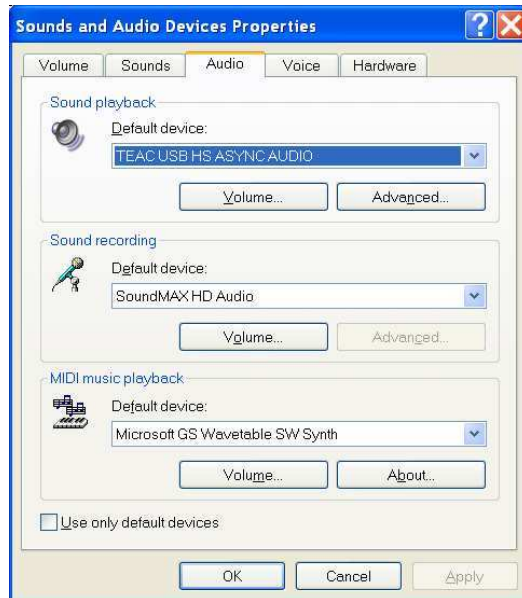

5. In the tab “**Audio**” select “**TEAC USB HS ASYNC AUDIO**“. Next go to “**Apply**” and confirm your settings with “**OK**”



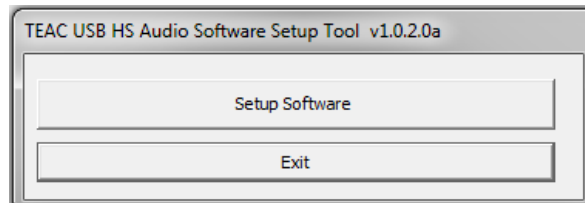
6. Your PC is now configured for audioplayback using your TEAC DAC.

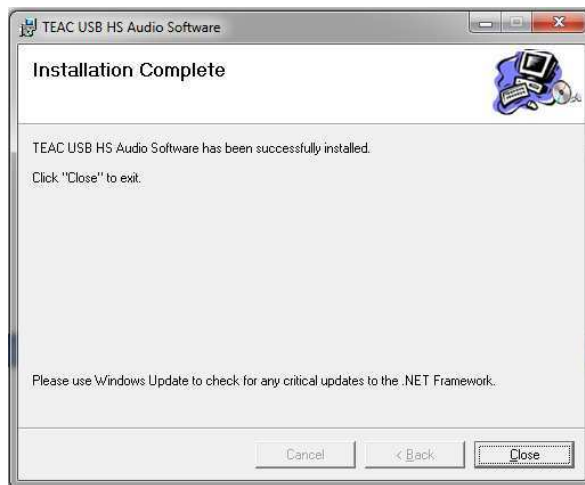
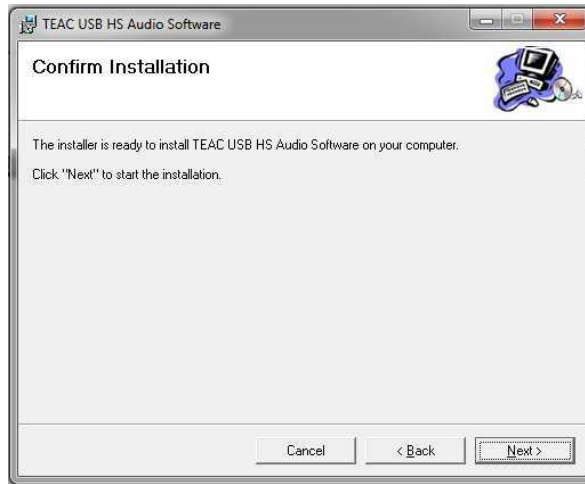
Please be aware that Windows XP will not support sample frequencies above 48 kHz. This requires appropriate audiosoftware.

Windows Vista / Windows 7

1. For installation of the device driver software, please execute „TEACUSBHSAudioSetup.exe“ and follow the instructions of the Setup Wizard.

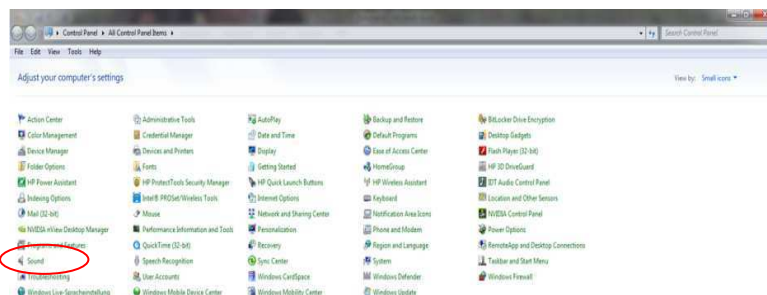


2. You can now connect your TEAC DAC to your PC via USB. Set the input SOURCE of your TEAC DAC to “USB”.

4. Open **Start - Control Panel - Sounds**



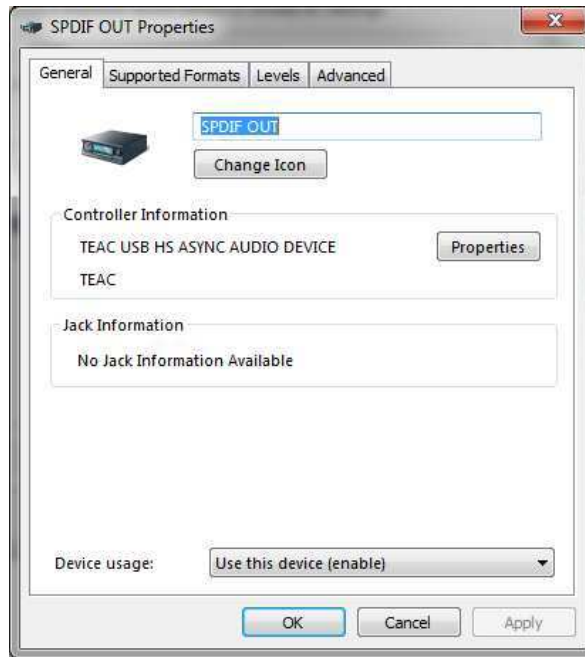
5. In the tab “**Playback**“ select “**TEAC USB HS ASYNC AUDIO Device**“ and press “**Set Default**“. Next go to “**Apply**“ and confirm your settings with“**OK**“



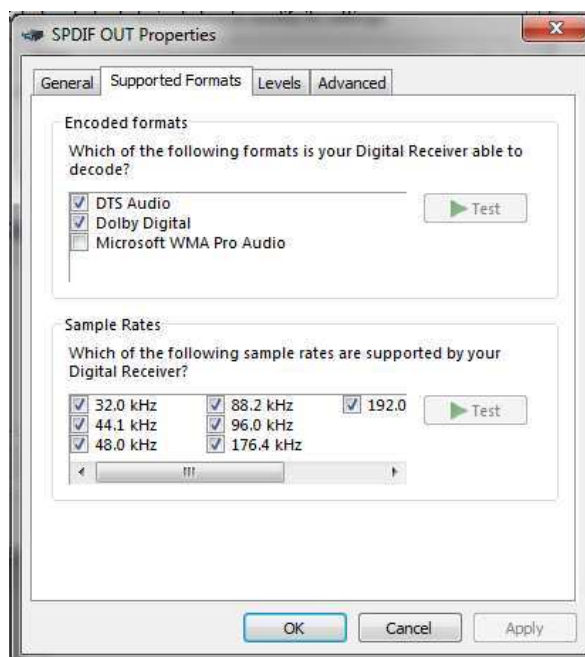
6. Following **Start - Control Panel - Sounds**, you have access to the settings of your TEAC DAC.

7. Navigate to the tab “**Playback**“ and open the “**Properties**”

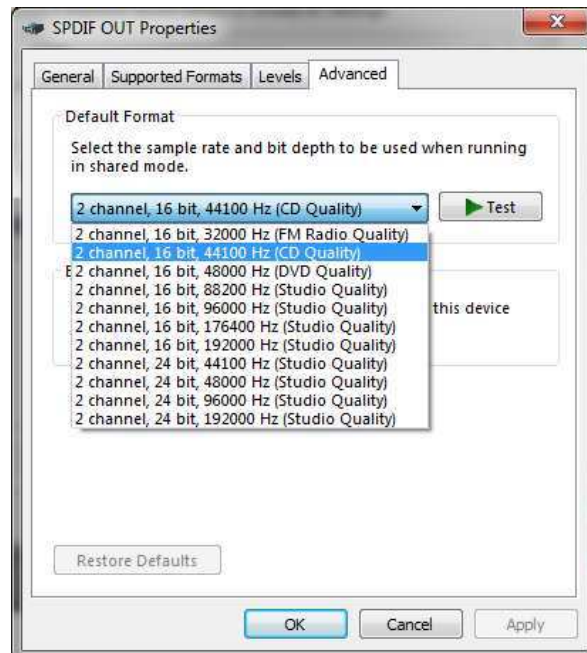




8. Open the tab “**Supported Formats**” to select the supported sample rates. Next go to “**Apply**” and confirm your settings with“**OK**”



9. Select the tab “**Advanced**” to determine the sample frequency and bit rate for your audio playback. Go to “**Apply**” and confirm your settings with “**OK**”.



10. Your PC is now configured for audioplayback using your TEAC DAC.

Please be aware that Windows Vista / Windows 7 will not support the sample frequencies 88,2 kHz/24 Bit and 176,4 kHz/24 Bit. Your standard Windows Media Player will also not support the “native” mode. This requires an appropriate audiosoftware.
